

Art Ed 352 Fundamental Three-Dimensional Computer Art Techniques

For this TA position, it is preferred that you have experience with 3-dimensional digital art and/or computer graphics. Experience teaching these are most valuable and desired.

TAs must follow the prescribed course description, general syllabus, syllabus calendar, course objectives, text and project assignments. Additional material, assignments, readings and resources can be added.

TAs for this course must attend meetings with supervisor and during first quarter of teaching this course, must register for 1 credit hour of independent study.

TAs must provide the supervisor with mid-quarter student evaluations.
