

Student Teaching Supervisor

The University Supervisor is expected to attend the University Supervisor orientation, class sessions for Art Education 689 during autumn quarter, student teaching seminars (winter and spring quarters), and cooperating teacher orientations.

The University Supervisors are required to meet with Mary Louise Poling, Ph.D., the Director of the Student Teaching Program, each week and when special meetings are held.

The University Supervisors are expected to complete all documents required by the Department of Art Education and the Educator Preparation Unit.

The University Supervisor is expected to observe each student teacher candidate five times in a ten-week quarter.

The University Supervisor is expected to be a liaison for the Department of Art Education and The Ohio State University. The University Supervisor is expected to maintain positive communication between field-based professionals, teacher candidates, and professionals at The Ohio State University.

The University Supervisor reports directly to Mary Louise Poling, Ph.D., the Director of the Student Teaching Program in the Department of Art Education.
