The responsibilities of your assignment will be to teach Art Education 367.01. Your supervisor will provide you with specific information regarding the expectations for this assignment.

Courses that do not meet the minimum enrollment requirement will be canceled and this offer of appointment will be withdrawn.

For your 367.01 assignment, TAs must follow the prescribed course description, general syllabus, syllabus calendar, course objectives, text and project assignments.

You will be required to attend meetings with your supervisor and during the first quarter of teaching this course, register for 1 credit hour of independent study.

You will also be required to turn in a syllabus for the course each quarter and provide the supervisor with mid-quarter student evaluations.

Please notify your supervisor as soon as any problems arise in the course. If you must be absent, your supervisor must be notified prior to making arrangements and seek approval of them.

It is advisable that TAs take a multicultural course. See supervisor for suggestions on these.

Our courses are taught for 10 weeks and you must be present during finals week for holding final exams or collecting final projects for grading.

Each TA must take Art Education 707: TA Development course.

Typical duties for Graduate Teaching Associates include: tutoring students, holding office hours, proctoring exams, grading student assignments, developing academic instructional materials, and other related duties as assigned.
