

THE LAWRENCE AND ISABEL BARNETT FELLOWSHIP IN ARTS POLICY AND ADMINISTRATION

Each year, the College of the Arts at The Ohio State University makes available two two-year fellowships for incoming graduate students at the M.A. or Ph.D. level in its Arts Policy and Administration Program. The fellowships, funded by the Lawrence and Isabel Barnett Fellowship Fund, pay the students' tuition and provide stipends. The Fund stipulates that the fellows "shall be selected on merit, with a preference for a student with need."
